

HAPPY BIRTHDAY NTLAC!

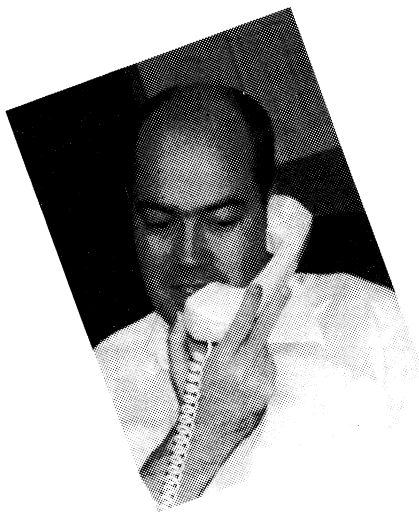
Legal Aid celebrated a milestone birthday when it turned ten years old in July. During the past ten years Legal Aid has served the legal needs of Territorians by granting aid and acting for over 15,500 clients in serious matters and giving free legal advice and minor assistance to more than 50,000 people. A Duty Lawyer Service, operating daily at the various Magistrates' Courts throughout the Territory, has assisted over 20,000 clients during this time. The Tollfree Legal Information Telephone Service (1800 019 343) has only been in operation for five years but over 13,000 people have been given information and referrals on a wide range of legal issues. 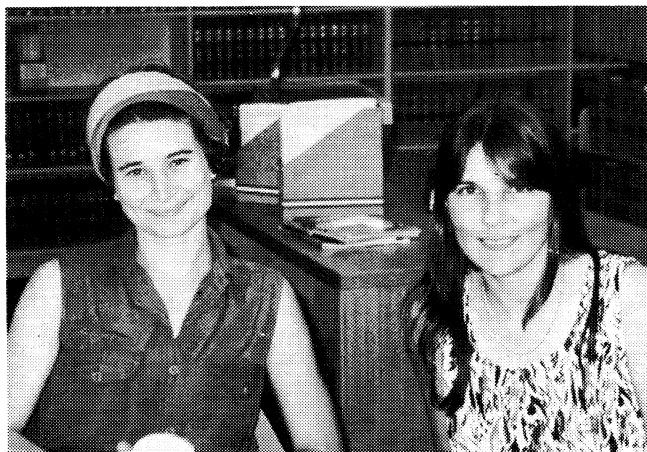

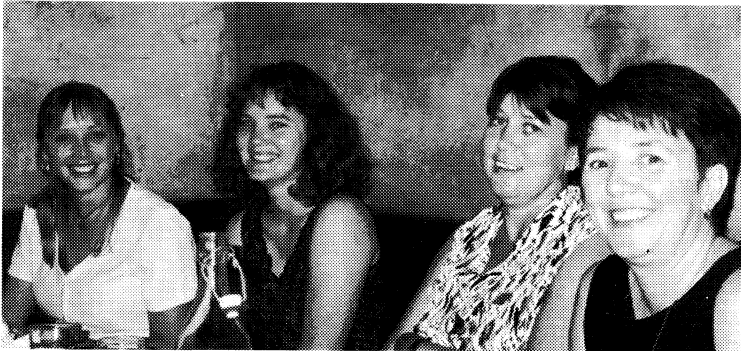
