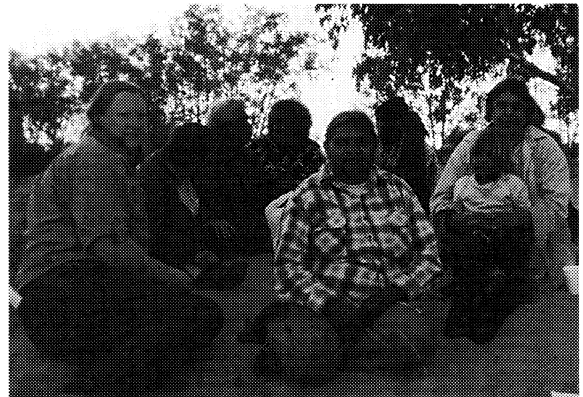
The meeting was facilitated by Elva Cook, a recipient of a Chief Ministers award for women this year.

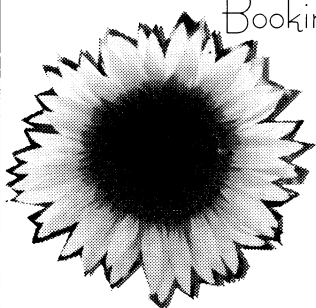
