

ADVISORY COUNCIL.

No. 13 of 1962.

An Ordinance to amend the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1961*.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1962*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1961*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1962*.

2. Section 3 of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1961* is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:— Interpretation.

“(2.) A person who is ordinarily resident in the Territory shall, for the purposes of sub-section (4.) of section five, and sub-section (1.) of section six, of this Ordinance, be deemed to have lived in the Territory for any period during which the person has been temporarily absent from the Territory.”
