Savings.

  - (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the declaration or appointment was made or the direction given, as the case may be; and
  - the declaration, appointment or direction had been made or given by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance.

PART V—AMENDMENTS OF THE INSTITUTE FOR THE STUDY OF MAN AND SOCIETY INCORPORATION ORDINANCE 1968

Repeal.

#### PART XI—AMENDMENT OF THE REGISTRATION OF DEEDS ORDINANCE 1957

29. (1) Section 3 of the Registration of Deeds Ordinance 1957\* General is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) the word "Attorney-Register of Deeds. General" and substituting the word "Minister".
