An Act to regulate smoking in aircraft and aerodromes

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

Short title etc

5 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Air Navigation (Smoking) Amendment Act 1987.

(2) The Air Navigation Act 1920 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Principal Act is amended by adding after section 26 the following section:

"Smoking in aircraft and aerodromes

"26A. (1) A person shall not smoke in any part of an aircraft other than an enclosed space designated in accordance with the regulations as a smoking bay.

Penalty: \$5,000 or imprisonment for 6 months.

"(2) A space in an aircraft designated as a smoking bay shall be ventilated in such a way that it is not possible for smoke in the air in the space to enter the air in any other part of the aircraft.

"(3) A person shall not smoke in any part of an aerodrome other than a room designated in accordance with the regulations as a smoking room.

Penalty: \$5,000 or imprisonment for 6 months.

"(4) A room in an aerodrome designated as a smoking room shall be ventilated in such a way that it is not possible for smoke in the air in the room to enter the air in any other part of the aerodrome.

"(5) In this section, 'aerodrome' means an aerodrome established under the regulations."
