ADDENDUM TO EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This addendum is in substitution for the two addenda previously issued.

Clause 18

10. Clause 18 also makes a number of transitional provisions (sub-clauses 1-6 and 8) designed to preserve appointments, promotions and transfers, oaths and undertakings made in relation to, and given by, persons who will continue to be members of the AFP. Sub-clause 18(7) provides that an appeal arising out of a selection for promotion which was made under the Principal Act before this Bill became law shall be heard and determined on the basis of the same criteria as that selection for promotion. Sub-clause 18(9) will protect the terms and conditions of service of a small number of former members of the Protective Service Component who are to retire on medical grounds and whose accrued leave entitlements extend beyond the date on which this Bill will become law. Sub-clause 18(12) contains necessary definitions.
