## ADDENDUM TO EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

(Circulated by Authority of the Special Minister of State)

This addendum is in substitution for the addendum previously issued.

#### Clause 18

10. Clause 18 also makes a number of transitional provisions (sub-clauses 1-6 and 8) designed to preserve appointments, promotions and transfers, oaths and undertakings made in relation to, and given by, persons who will continue to be members of the AFP. Sub-clause 18(7) provides that an appeal arising out of a selection for promotion which was made under the Principal Act before this Bill became law shall be heard and determined on the basis of the same criteria as that selection for promotion. Sub-clause 18(11) contains necessary definitions.

#### Clause 16A

11. This clause limits the right of members to appeal against the promotion of other members to positions in such ranks as are prescribed.
