NOTES ON CLAUSES

<u> Clause 1 - Title (Clause 1, page 1)</u> <u>Clause 4 - Title (page 1)</u>

1. These amendments change the name of the Bill from Arts, Sport, Environment and Tourism Legislation Amendment Bill 1991 to Arts, Sport, Environment, Tourism and Territories Legislation Amendment Bill (No. 2) 1991. This is because the amendment now proposed, described in paragraph 4, below, relates to Territories. The <u>Arts, Sport, Environment, Tourism</u> <u>and Territories Legislation Amendment Act 1991</u> was passed in the Autumn 1991 Sittings of Parliament.

Clause 2 - Amendments of Acts (Clause 3, page 1)

2. This clause inserts a transitional provision that is identical to subsection 32(2) of the <u>Industrial Relations</u> <u>Legislation Amendment Act 1991</u>. That Act contains provisions implementing the Government's Decision that recreation leave entitlements of all full-time statutory office holders are to be determined by the Remuneration Tribunal, which are implemented in this Bill in respect of statutory authorities administered by the Department of ASETT.

3. This transitional provision ensures that whatever rights to recreation leave the affected person had accrued prior to commencement of this Bill are preserved following commencement.

Clause 3 - Inclusion of Further Amendment (Schedule, page 21

4. This clause inserts an amendment to section 38 of the Australian Capital Territory (Planning and Land Management) Act 1988. The amendment will apply the Government's decision referred to in paragraph 2, above, to full-time members of the National Capital Planning Authority. This amendment was accidentally omitted from the Bill as introduced.
