AUSTRALIAN TOURIST COMMISSION (TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS) BILL 1987

Outline

The purpose of this Bill is to:

- . enable the existing Managing Director of the Australian Tourist Commission to continue in accordance with the terms and conditions of his original appointment.
- . repeal existing Acts to allow the Australian Tourist Commission Act 1987 to come into effect.

Financial Impact Statement

No additional financial implications directly flow from this legislation

NOTES ON CLAUSES

Clauses 1 and 2

The first two clauses of the Bill provide for the short title and commencement of the legislation on the day to be fixed by proclamation under the Australian Tourist Commission Act 1987.

Clause 3 - Managing Director

Provides for the existing Managing Director to continue in accordance with the terms and conditions of his original appointment.

Clause 4 - Repeal

Repeals existing Acts, thus allowing the Australian Tourist Commission Act 1987 to come into effect.
