NOTES ON CLAUSES

Clauses 1 and 2

These two clauses provide for the short title and the commencement of the legislation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Clause 3 - Repeal

This clause provides for the repeal of the Commonwealth Employees (Employment Provisions) Act 1977.

OUTLINE

1. The Commonwealth Employees (Employment Provisions) Repeal Bill 1983 has the purpose of repealing the Commonwealth Employees (Employment Provisions) Act 1977 (the Act).
2. The Act was enacted in 1977 and came into operation in 1979.
3. The Act provides for:
 - . the suspension of Commonwealth employees engaging in industrial action
 - . the standing down of Commonwealth employees affected by industrial action
 - . the dismissal of Commonwealth employees who have been suspended.
