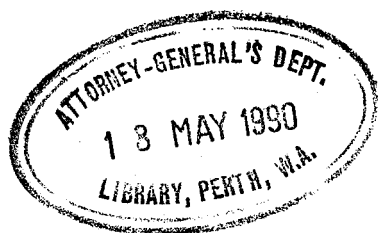

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AMENDMENTS TO BE MOVED ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT TO THE
CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT BILL (NO. 2) 1987

OUTLINE

The purpose of the amendments to be moved to the Customs Tariff Amendment Bill (No. 2) 1987 is to correct printing and proofreading errors -

. Amendment 1

- "4002.92.90" should read "4202.92.90" (Amendment No. 47 of Schedule 3 to the Customs Tariff Act 1987 (P. 11));

. Amendment 2

- insert a General Tariff rate of "20%" for goods of 8714.19.10 and clearly indicate that the DC rate of 15% also applies to those goods and not to goods of 8714.19.90. A rate of 2% applies to goods of 8714.19.90 (Amendment No. 123 of Schedule 3 to the Customs Tariff Act 1987 (P. 23)); and

. Amendment 3

- insert the word "by" after "prescribed" in item 36A
- in the TABLE to item 36B
 - "2836.23.00" should read "2835.23.00" and
 - "3602.94.00" should read "3702.94.00"

(Amendment No. 1 of Part III of Schedule 4 to the Customs Tariff Act 1987 (P. 24)).
