



NOTES ON CLAUSES

Clause 1 - Short Title

3. Provides for the Act to be called the Exotic Animal Disease Control Amendment Act 1995 and defines the "Principal Act" as the Exotic Animal Disease Control Act 1989.

Clause 2 - Commencement

4. Provides for the Act to commence on 1 July 1995.

Clause 3 - Amendments

5. Provides for the *Exotic Animal Disease Control Act 1989* to be amended by the Schedule.

SCHEDULE - AMENDMENTS OF THE PRINCIPAL ACT

Exotic Animal Disease Control Act 1989

Items 1 and 2: Section 24 - Interpretation

6. This amendment replaces the references to the Australian Meat and Live-stock Corporation Act 1977 and the Meat Research Corporation Act 1985 with references to the Meat and Live-stock Industry Act 1995 so that any money remaining after the sunset of the Exotic Animal Disease Control Act 1989 on 30 June 1995 will be returned to the Australian Meat and Live-stock Corporation and the Meat Research Corporation to be used for industry's behalf. This is a consequential amendment arising from the introduction of the Meat and Live-stock Industry Act 1995.
