Eggs (Export Inspection Charge) Bill 1982

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OUTLINE

Eggs (Export Inspection Charge) Bill 1982

This Bill provides for a charge to apply to eggs inspected under the provisions of the Exports (Dairy Produce) Regulations.

Provision is made for the imposition of charges and for rates of charge to be prescribed subject to a maximum of \$22.00 per 1000 dozen for eggs in shell and \$16.00 per tonne for other egg products. Different rates of charge may be prescribed for different classes of eggs. The Bill includes provision for exemptions from the charge to be made in regulations. The Bill also specifies by whom the charge is payable.
