SUPPLEMENTARY EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Amendments to be Moved on Behalf
of the Government

(Circulated by authority of the Minister for
Aboriginal Affairs, the Honourable Gerry Hand, MP)

All amendments other than amendment (7) would provide for the alteration of the name of the Institute to be established by the Bill to the 'Australian Institute of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Affairs'.

Amendment (7) would omit clause 62 of the Bill. The re-transfer of officers to Australian Public Service of officers who take up the office of Principal of the Institute could be better dealt with by regulations made under s.87 of the Public Service Act 1922.

The amendments would have no financial impact.
