REPLACEMENT SUPPLEMENTARY EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Amendments to be moved on behalf of the Government

OUTLINE

The purpose of the amendments to be moved to the Industrial Relations (Consequential Provisions) Bill 1988 is to make additional consequential amendments to the definition provisions of the Remuneration Tribunals Act 1973 following the enactment of the Employment, Education and Training Act 1988.

FINANCIAL IMPACT STATEMENT

These proposed amendments have no financial impact.

AMENDMENT NOTES

Amendment 1 deletes the item intended to amend the definition of "organization" in the Postal Services Act 1975 in anticipation of proposed legislation reforming the Australian Postal Commission.

Amendments 2 to 7 involve amendments to definition provisions of the Remuneration Tribunals Act 1973 as a consequence of the enactment of the Employment, Education and Training Act 1988.

Amendment 8 deletes the item intended to amend the definition of "organization" in the Telecommunications Act 1975 in anticipation of proposed legislation reforming the Australian Telecommunications Commission.
