#### LIVE-STOCK EXPORT CHARGE AMENDMENT (AAHC) BILL 1996

#### **GENERAL OUTLINE**

1. The purpose of the Live-stock Export Charge Amendment (AAHC) Bill 1996 is to amend the *Live-stock Export Charge Act 1977* to impose charges to finance the Australian Animal Health Council Limited (AAHC). The purpose of this amendment is to amend the retrospective application of the charges.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT STATEMENT

2. Payments to the AAHC will be drawn from levy arrangements established by the Australian Animal Health Council (Live-stock Industries) Funding Bill 1996, and will have no impact on the Commonwealth Budget.

## **NOTES ON INDIVIDUAL CLAUSES**

3. This amendment amends the application dates so that the charges come into effect on the first day of the month following a period of 30 days after the Act commences.
