AMENDMENT TO THE MARITIME COLLEGE
AMENDMENT BILL 1986

OUTLINE

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the position in regard to students who formerly enrol only once in a course of study that may extend across more than one calendar year. It was the Government's intention that students contribute to the administration costs of institutions in respect of each calendar year.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no further reductions in Commonwealth outlays beyond those advised at the time of the introduction of the Bill.

NOTES ON CLAUSES

Clause 2: Interpretation: The amendment has the effect of deeming continuing students to have enrolled separately for each year of their course and makes the collection of the Administration Charge a condition of enrolment.
