PARLIAMENT HOUSE CONSTRUCTION AUTHORITY REPEAL BILL 1992

OUTLINE

The purpose of this Bill is to repeal the *Parliament House Construction Authority Act 1979* as the Parliament House Construction Authority has fulfilled its obligations under the Act.

This Bill is to come into effect on Royal Assent.

FINANCIAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The Bill has no financial impact.

NOTES ON CLAUSES

Clause 1 - Short title etc.

1. Sub-clause 1(1) provides for the Act to be cited as the *Parliament House Construction Authority Repeal Act 1992*.

2. Sub-clause 1(2) provides the 'Principal Act' means the *Parliament House Construction Authority Act 1979*.

Clause 2 - Commencement

3. This clause provides for the Act to commence on Royal Assent.

Clause 3 - Interpretation

4. This clause defines 'Authority' in the Bill as meaning the *Parliament House Construction Authority*.

Clause 4 - Repeal

5. This clause repeals the Principal Act.

Clause 5 - Commonwealth Successor in law of the Authority

6. This clause provides for the Commonwealth to be the successor of the Authority for all legal purposes.
