NOTES ON CLAUSES

Clause 100 - Issuing apparatus licences

Insert new -

Clause 100(3) ensures that the prohibition in subclause 100(2) does not prevent apparatus licences being issued under clause 100 authorising operation of transmitters used by national broadcasting services in those parts of the broadcasting services bands that have been reserved by the Minister under section 31 of the BSA for those services.

Renumber -

Clauses 100(3), (4), (5) and (6) to read Clause 100(4), Clause 100(5), Clause 100(6) and Clause 100(7) respectively to take account of the insertion of new Clause 100(3).
