

INVALID AND OLD-AGE PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

No. 11 of 1931.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 22nd July, 1931.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Appropriation Act 1931*.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act 1901-1926*, and known as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Ten million pounds for invalid and old-age pensions.

LOAN.

No. 12 of 1931.

An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending
of a certain Sum of Money.

[Assented to 22nd July, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Loan Act 1931*.

2. The Treasurer may, from time to time, under the provisions of the *Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1927*, or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Fifteen million pounds.

3. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for the purpose set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

4. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.

CUSTOMS TARIFF (CANADIAN PREFERENCE).

No. 13 of 1931.

An Act relating to Preferential Duties of Customs on Goods the Produce or Manufacture of the Dominion of Canada, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 25th July, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Customs Tariff (Canadian Preference) 1931*.

Short title.

2. This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.

Commencement.
