No. 6 of 1969

An Act to amend section 3 of the *Spirits Act* 1906–1968.

[Assented to 8 April 1969]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Spirits Act* 1969.

(2.) The *Spirits Act* 1906–1968,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Spirits Act* 1906–1969.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Interpretation.

3. Section 3 of the *Spirits Act* 1906–1968 is amended—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of “ Pure Australian Standard Brandy ” the word “ forty ” and inserting in its stead the word “ forty-five ”; and

(b) by omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of “ Australian Blended Brandy ” the word “ forty ” and inserting in its stead the word “ forty-five ”.
