

## CUSTOMS TARIFF.

### No. 22 of 1923.

An Act relating to Duties of Customs on Sulphur.

[Assented to 1st September, 1923.]

**BE** it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Customs Tariff* 1923.  
 (2.) The *Customs Tariff* 1921–1922, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Customs Tariff* 1921–1923.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.

Duty on sulphur.

3. The *Customs Tariff* 1921–1922 is amended by inserting in Item 275 of the Schedule, after sub-Item A (1), the following proviso :—

“ Provided that, so long as a bounty is payable on sulphur under any law of the Commonwealth, the importation of sulphur to which this sub-Item applies shall be free of duty.”

## SHALE OIL BOUNTY.

### No. 23 of 1923.

An Act to amend the *Shale Oil Bounty Act* 1917–1922.

[Assented to 1st September, 1923.]

Preamble.

**BE** it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Shale Oil Bounty Act* 1923.  
 (2.) The *Shale Oil Bounty Act* 1917–1922 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Shale Oil Bounty Act 1917-1923*.

2. Section two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "six years" and inserting in their stead the words "nine years".

Period during which bounty payable.

3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) thereof the words "six years" and inserting in their stead the words "nine years".

Specification of bounty.

4. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended—

Amendment of the Schedule.

(a) by omitting from the second column the figure "6" and inserting in its stead the figure "9"; and

(b) by omitting from the fourth column the figures "1923" and inserting in their stead the figures "1926".

## SPECIAL ANNUITY.

### No. 24 of 1923.

An Act to provide for the Payment of an Annuity to the Widow of the late the Honorable Frank Gwynne Tudor.

[ Assented to 1st September, 1923.]

**BE** it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Special Annuity Act 1923*.

Short title.

2.—(1.) Subject to this Act, there shall be payable, out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, to the widow of the late the Honorable Frank Gwynne Tudor, an annuity at the rate of One hundred and fifty-six pounds per annum.

Annuity to widow of the late the Hon. F. G. Tudor.

(2.) The annuity provided by this Act shall cease to be payable in the event of the re-marriage of the annuitant.
