CRIMINAL LAW AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1964.

An Ordinance to amend the Criminal Law Amendment Ordinance 1939-1960.

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Law Short title and Amendment Ordinance 1964.

- (2.) The Criminal Law Amendment Ordinance 1939-1960 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Criminal Law Amendment Ordinance 1939-1964.
- 2. After section eight of the Principal Ordinance the Repeal of section 14 of following section is inserted:—

"8AA. Section fourteen of the Act is repealed.".
