FIREARMS ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1974

No. 48 of 1974

An Ordinance to amend the *Firearms Ordinance* 1956 as amended

[Assented to 23 September 1974]

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Firearms Ordinance* short title (No. 2) 1974.

2. The Firearms Ordinance 1956 as amended is in this principal Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section 44 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

Exemptions

- (a) by omitting from sub-sections (2) and (3) "2 days" and substituting "7 days"; and
- (b) by inserting after sub-section (3) the following sub-section:

"(3A) While an exemption of a person under sub-section (1) is in force, the firearm in respect of which the exemption relates shall, for the purposes of section 41, be deemed to be a registered firearm and, in the case of a pistol or high powered firearm, to be held by that person under a licence.".
