

FIREARMS ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1974

An Ordinance to amend the *Firearms Ordinance* 1956 as amended

[Assented to 23 September 1974]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Firearms Ordinance* (No. 2) 1974. Short title
 2. The *Firearms Ordinance* 1956 as amended is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance
 3. Section 44 of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Exemptions
 - (a) by omitting from sub-sections (2) and (3) “2 days” and substituting “7 days”; and
 - (b) by inserting after sub-section (3) the following sub-section:

“(3A) While an exemption of a person under sub-section (1) is in force, the firearm in respect of which the exemption relates shall, for the purposes of section 41, be deemed to be a registered firearm and, in the case of a pistol or high powered firearm, to be held by that person under a licence.”
