

NOMENCLATURE (PUBLIC PLACES) ORDINANCE 1966

No. 30 of 1966

An Ordinance to amend the *Nomenclature (Public Places) Ordinance 1945*

[Assented to 7th September, 1966.]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1965*, as follows:—

Short title
and citation

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Nomenclature (Public Places) Ordinance 1966*.

(2.) The *Nomenclature (Public Places) Ordinance 1945* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Nomenclature (Public Places) Ordinance 1945-1966*.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting the word “Minister” (first occurring) and inserting in its stead the word “Administrator”; and

(b) by omitting the word “Minister” (second occurring) and inserting in its stead the word “Administrator”.

3. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word “Minister” and inserting in its stead the words “Administrator in Council”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the word “Minister” and inserting in its stead the words “Administrator in Council”.
