## NATIONAL PARKS AND GARDENS (ORMISTON GORGE AND POUND SCENIC RESERVE) BY-LAWS

Citation

1. These By-laws may be cited as the National Parks and Gardens (Ormiston Gorge and Pound Scenic Reserve) By-laws.

Definitions

Fires

- 2. In these By-laws, "the Reserve" means the land that was committed to the care, control and management of the Board by notice in Northern Territory Government Gazette No. 37 of 1966 dated 3 August, 1966.
- 3. A person shall not light a wood fire on the Reserve except in a fireplace provided by the Board.

Penalty: One hundred dollars.
