## By-laws under the *National Parks and Gardens Ordinance 1959-1968*

The Northern Territory Reserves Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the *National Parks and Gardens Ordinance 1959-1968*, at a meeting held on the eight day of May, 1969, made the following By-laws.

### NATIONAL PARKS AND GARDENS (KATHERINE LOW LEVEL RESERVE) BY-LAWS.

1. These By-laws may be cited as the National Parks and Gardens (Katherine Low Level Reserve) By-laws. Citation
  
2. In these By-laws, "the Reserve" means the land that was committed to the care, control and management of the Board by notice in *Northern Territory Government Gazette* No. 23 of 1965 dated 9 June, 1965. Definitions
  
3. The Reserve is open to the public only from seven o'clock in the morning until ten o'clock in the evening. Admission times
  
4. A person shall not light a wood fire on the Reserve except in a fire-place provided by the Board. Fires  
Penalty: One hundred dollars.
  
5. A person shall not drive a vehicle on an unsealed road on the Reserve at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour. Speed limit  
Penalty: Fifty dollars.
  
6. (1.) Subject to the next succeeding clause of this by-law, a person shall not drive a vehicle on the Reserve except on a road. Driving off roads and parking  
Penalty: Fifty dollars.  
(2.) A person may drive a short distance off a road for the purpose of parking.
  
7. A person shall not fish or use a boat to the danger of people in the reserve. Boats and fishing  
Penalty: One hundred dollars.

*National Parks and Gardens (Katherine Low Level Reserve) By-laws*

Horses

8. (1.) Except under licence from the Board, a person shall not keep a horse on the Reserve.

(2.) A person who permits a horse belonging to him or in his charge to enter or remain on a reserve shall ensure that it is kept under proper control.

Dogs

(3.) A person who permits a dog belonging to him or in his charge to enter or remain on the Reserve shall ensure that—

- (a) it is securely held on a leash;
- (b) it does not enter the water; and
- (c) it does not enter a building.

Penalty: One hundred dollars.
