
Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance*

AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS

1. Regulation 31 of the Public Service Regulations is amended by inserting **Salaries** after sub-regulation (1A) the following sub-regulation:

“(1AC) Notwithstanding the classification of such an office, the rate or scale of rates specified in Table B in sub-regulation (1) that is applicable to an office shall be further increased—

- (a) with effect from and including 27 May 1976, for the purpose of calculating salary; and
- (b) with effect from and including 10 June 1976, for the purpose of calculating extraneous payments based on salary, on account of variations in the cost of living by an amount equal to—
- (c) in the case where a rate as increased up to but not including 27 May 1976, is not more than \$6521, 3% of that rate as increased; or
- (d) in the case where a rate as so increased is more than \$6521, \$198.”.

2. Regulation 51(1) of the Public Service Regulations is amended by omitting “\$15,505” and substituting “\$15,703”.
