

Regulations under the *Public Service Ordinance*  
1928-1962.

I PAUL MEERNA CAEDWALLA HASLUCK, the Minister of State for Territories, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1962, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS.†

1. After regulation 69 of the Public Service Regulations the following regulation is inserted in Division 3 of Part IV:—

“69A.—(1.) Where the family of a deceased person who was an officer resided with him in the Territory before his death or retirement, the Minister may, if he thinks fit, after having had regard to—

Payment of removal expenses on death or retirement of officer.

(a) the time spent by the person and his family in the Territory; and

(b) any other matters that the Minister considers relevant,

authorize the payment to the person's widow or to a member of his family of the whole or such part as the Minister thinks fit of the expenses incurred in the conveyance of herself and her family (if any) or the member of the family and any other members of the family, as the case may be, and of the furniture and household effects of the family from the Territory to any place in Australia.

“(2.) Where an officer retires or is retired from the Public Service and his family resided with him in the Territory before his retirement, the Minister may, if he thinks fit after having regard to—

(a) the time spent by the officer in the Territory; and

(b) any other matters that the Minister considers relevant,

authorize the payment to the officer of the whole, or such part as the Minister thinks fit, of the expenses incurred in the conveyance of the officer and his family (if any) and his furniture and household effects from the Territory to Adelaide, Brisbane, Perth, Sydney or Melbourne or to such other place in Australia as the Minister, in any particular case, determines.”
