An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1955.

[Assented to 27th November, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Amendment Act, 1958". Short title.

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1955, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1958".

(3) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1955, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection — Amendment of s. 12 of principal Act—Salaries of judges.

(1) The salary of the Chief Justice shall be at the rate of five thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds a year, and the salary of every puisne judge shall be at the rate of five thousand pounds a year.

Operation of
Act.

4. The rates of salary as altered by this Act shall be deemed to have come into force for all purposes (including contributions for pension and rights to pension) on the first of July, 1958.
