An Act to repeal certain Acts relating to health.

[Assented to 17 November 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutes Repeal (Health) Act, 1983".
- Repeal of Acts. 2. The Acts set out in the schedule are repealed.

SCHEDULE

- Infectious Diseases Hospital Transfer Act, 1947
- Mental Institution Benefits Act, 1948
- Tuberculosis (Commonwealth Arrangement) Act, 1949
- Vaccination Act, 1936
- Whyalla Hospital (Vesting) Act, 1969.
