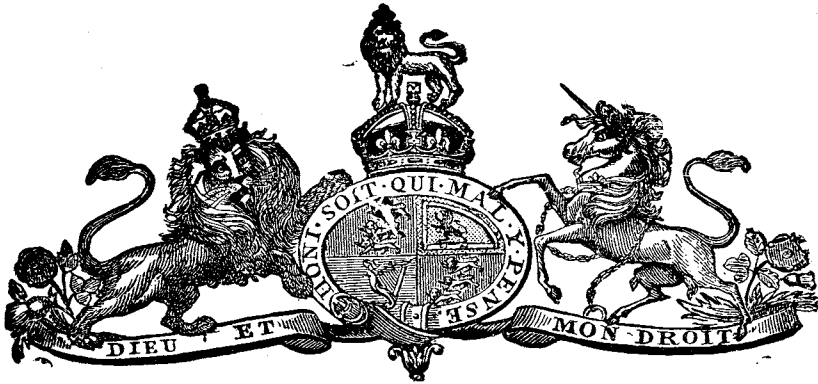

AN ACT to amend the *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1928*. [2 November, 1934.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1934*.

Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By inserting after the word “not” in the third line of the Section 3. definition of skin in section three thereof the words “in the case of a partly protected animal”:

II. By expunging paragraph xxix. of section eighteen thereof and substituting therefor the following new paragraph xxix :—

“ xxix. Imposing penalties for breaches of the regulations with power to impose —

- (a) Different penalties for successive breaches of any regulation ;
- (b) Daily penalties not exceeding five pounds for each day ; and
- (c) Penalties in addition to any general penalty not exceeding five pounds in respect of each and every—
 - i. Animal, bird, carcase, or skin : or
 - ii. Snare, net, gun, lamp, lantern, light, trap, or other engine—

with respect to which a breach of any regulation has been committed—

but no such penalty shall exceed fifty pounds, and the aggregate of all such penalties in respect of any individual breach shall in no case exceed fifty pounds.”:

Section 24.

III. By inserting after the word “unprotected” in the fifth line of section twenty-four thereof the words “and the skins of all such animals shall within the sanctuary be deemed to be the skins of wholly protected animals” : and

Repeal of section 31 and substitution of new section.

IV. By repealing section thirty-one thereof and substituting therefor the following new section thirty-one—

“ 31—(1) Every—

- i. Animal or bird :
- ii. Carcase, skin, or egg of any animal or bird : and
- iii. Engine or article—

taken, bought, sold, exported, had in possession, used, or intended to be used or dealt with, as the case may be, in contravention of any of the provisions of this Act, is hereby forfeited to the Board, and shall be disposed of as the Board may determine or as may be prescribed.

(2) Such forfeiture or disposal shall not confer upon any person any right to compensation.”.

Amendment of 21 Geo. V. No. 69 and repeal of 23 Geo. V. No. 33.

3—(1) Section three of the *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1930*, is hereby amended by substituting the word “thirty-seven” for the word “thirty-five” at the end thereof (inserted by the *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1932*).

(2) The *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1932* is hereby repealed.
