

# VICTORIÆ REGINÆ,

No. 36.

AN ACT to authorise the raising of Loans for Public Works on the Security of the Land Fund of the Colony. [5 November, 1858.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to enable the Government to borrow a PREAMBLE. sum of money, not exceeding in the whole £26,500, for the execution of the permanent Works of public utility and convenience set out in the Schedule hereto: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled. as follows:-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Executive Power to raise Council, from time to time, to raise by the issue and sale of Debentures £26,500 for secured upon the Land Fund of the Colony, in like manner as is prescribed Public Works by in the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 20th Victoria, No. 9, and bearing Interest at a rate not exceeding £6 per centum per annum, Land Fund. such sum or sums of money, not exceeding £26,500, as may be required or the construction and completion of the several Public Works set out in the Schedule hereto; such Debentures to be redeemable as follows: that is to say-

As to the amount of £11,500 in the year 1869; As to the amount of £5000 in the year 1870; As to the amount of £5000 in the year 1871; As to the amount of £5000 in the year 1872.

#### 22° VICTORIÆ No 36.

Provisions of 20 Vict. No. 9, to apply to such Debentures.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, No. 9, shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act are fully and off the limit of the limi of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several Sections, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
