AN ACT to amend the *Drainage Act* 1934. [25 May, 1955.]

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title ind citation.

- **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Drainage Act* 1955.
- (2) The Drainage Act 1934, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 After section twenty-four of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:

Borrowing on overdraft.

- "24A—(1) Subject to this section, a trust may, for the purposes of temporary accommodation, obtain advances from any bank by overdraft on the current account of the trust.
- (2) An advance obtained by a trust under this section shall not at any time exceed one-half of the revenue of the trust for the financial year preceding that in which the trust obtains the advance.".

Power to levy rates.

3 Section twenty-five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word "sixpence" and substituting therefor the word "ninepence".
