FORESTRY AMENDMENT ACT 1996

No. 66 of 1996

An Act to amend the Forestry Act 1920

[Royal Assent 16 December 1996]

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Forestry Amendment Act 1996.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, the *Forestry Act 1920** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 4 amended (Interpretation)

4. Section 4(1) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the following definition after the definition of "forest road":

"forestry purposes" includes purposes which facilitate conservation, environmental care and recreation on land which is State forest;
