LAND TITLES (RAILTON SPECIAL PROVISIONS) ACT 1995

No. 80 of 1995

AN ACT to enable the Recorder of Titles to issue new certificates of title for certain land at Railton affected by the realignment of Redwater Creek

[Royal Assent 14 November 1995]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Land Titles (Railton Special Provisions) Act 1995.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Interpretation

- 3-In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears-
 - "plan" means the Plan of Survey No. 40640 lodged in the Central Plan Office, a reduced copy of which is shown by way of illustration only in Schedule 1;
 - "relevant folio of the Register" means a folio of the Register specified in Schedule 2;
 - "subject lot" means a lot comprised in Section D or E of the town of Railton which is numbered and delineated in the plan.

Vesting of land

- 4—(1) Where, immediately before the commencement of this Act, any land that is comprised and described in a subject lot was not vested in the person specified as the registered proprietor of that lot in column 2 of Schedule 2, that land vests, by force of this section, in that person.
- (2) A vesting of land under subsection (1) does not affect any estate or interest to which that land was subject immediately before the commencement of this Act.

Issue of new certificates of title

5—The Recorder of Titles may cancel a relevant certificate of title and issue a new certificate of title so as to give effect to a vesting of land provided for by section 4.


Administration of Act


- 6—Until an order is made under section 4 of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1990—
 - (a) this Act is administered by the Minister for Environment and Land Management; and
 - (b) the Department responsible to the Minister in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Environment and Land Management.
