AN ACT to amend the Nurses' Registration Act 1952.

[Royal Assent 22 November 1984]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Nurses' Registration Amendment Act* 1984. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on 1st December 1984.

Commencement.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Nurses' Registration Act 1952** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4—Section 11 (1) (a) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subparagraph (i) and substituting the following subparagraph:—

(i) general nursing—

- (A) has attended the practice, lectures, and training provided by an approved training institution; or
- (B) has completed, and passed examinations in, an approved course at the school of nursing of an approved training institution, and is the holder of a diploma or degree issued by that institution in respect of that course;
