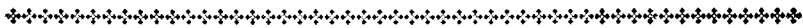

AN ACT to amend the *Public Health Act 1935*. A.D. 1941.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By inserting at the end of section one hundred and twenty-two thereof the following new subsection (5)—

“ (5) The provisions of this section shall not prevent the erection of any building on any allotment of land if such allotment—

- I. Forms part of land which was subdivided into building allotments prior to the fifteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine: and
- II. Was purchased or acquired as a building allotment by the person proposing to erect such building before the date aforesaid—

and such building could, on the date aforesaid, have been lawfully erected thereon.”:

II. By expunging subsection (10) of section one hundred and thirty-seven thereof.

Exercise by
Secretary of
functions of
Director.

3—(1) The provisions of subsection (2) of section six of the Principal Act shall apply to the absence from the State of the Director on war service as if the office of the Director were vacant during such service.

(2) The provisions of this section shall be deemed to have been in operation on and from the thirteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and forty, and shall apply to all acts and proceedings of the Secretary in the exercise of any functions of the Director as if they had been enacted on that date.
