BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Execution Act* (No. 2) 1938. Short title.

2 The Minister may cause the works mentioned in the schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding the amount therein specified.

3 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of one hundred and thirteen thousand six hundred pounds for defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.
