AN ACT to amend the Shop Trading Hours Act 1984

[Royal Assent 31 August 1990]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Shop Trading Hours Amendment Act 1990.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Shop Trading Hours Act 1984* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 5A substituted

4—Section 5A of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted:—

Special provision for certain shops

- 5A-(1) Notwithstanding section 5, a shop to which that section applies which is located in—
 - (a) the city of Launceston; or
 - (b) the city of Devonport; or
- (c) the municipality of Ulverstone—may be kept open at any time on 27 October 1990.
- (2) Section 8 does not apply in relation to any work as an employee in a shop referred to in subsection (1) on 27 October 1990.
