AN ACT to amend the Transport Act 1938.

[5 October 1978]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Transport Act 1978*.
- (2) The *Transport Act 1938**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

2 Section 4A of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) the word “ three ” and substituting the word “ two ”; and
- (b) by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:—

“(2) Of the persons appointed as Associate Commissioners—

- (a) one shall be a person who appears to the Governor to have had experience and to have shown capacity in public transport operations and in the administration and control of road traffic; and
- (b) one shall be a person who appears to the Governor to have had experience and to have shown capacity in the administration of transport.”.

Constitution of
Commission.

3 Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) the word “ three ” and substituting the word “ two ”.

Reconstitution
of Commission.

4—(1) On the day on which this Act commences the Commission shall be reconstituted in accordance with the provisions of the Principal Act, as amended by this Act.

(2) The reconstitution of the Commission does not affect any rights or obligations of the Commission.
