

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING.

---

### No. 18 of 1963.

#### AN ACT to amend the *Town and Country Planning Act 1944* and the *Local Government Act 1962*.

[2 May 1963.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Town and Country Planning Act 1963*.

**2**—(1) The *Town and Country Planning Act 1944* is amended by inserting after section four the following section:—

Deputy  
Commissioner.

“4A—(1) The Governor may appoint a Deputy Commissioner for Town and Country Planning who shall be the deputy of the Commissioner to exercise all his powers and perform all his functions as the Commissioner directs.

“(2) A Deputy Commissioner for Town and Country Planning shall be a person of special ability and experience in town and country planning.

“(3) Subsection (2) of section four applies as well to the Deputy Commissioner of Town and Country Planning as to the Commissioner.”.

(2) This section expires on the commencement of the *Local Government Act 1962*.

**3** The *Local Government Act 1962* is amended by inserting after section seven hundred and eighteen the following section:—

Deputy  
Commissioner.

“718A—(1) The Governor may appoint a Deputy Commissioner for Town and Country Planning who shall be the deputy of the Commissioner to exercise all his powers and perform all his functions as the Commissioner directs.

“(2) A Deputy Commissioner for Town and Country Planning shall be a person of special ability and experience in town and country planning.

“(3) Subsection (2) of section seven hundred and eighteen, excluding paragraph (g), applies as well to the Deputy Commissioner of Town and Country Planning as to the Commissioner.”.
