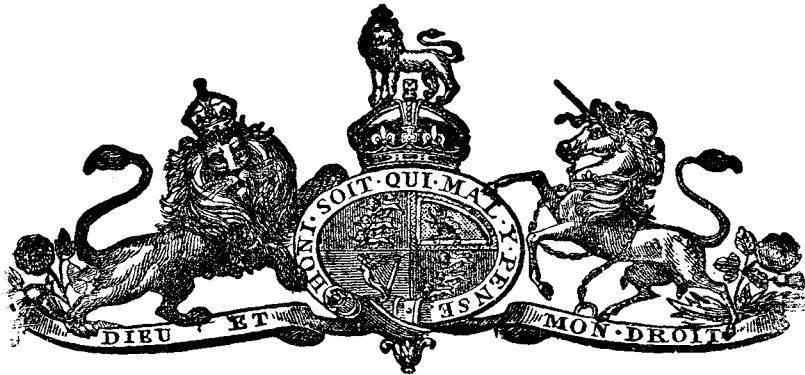

AN ACT to amend "The Franklin Lighting Act, 1913."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Franklin Lighting Act, Short title 1925."

(2) "The Franklin Lighting Act, 1913," is herein called "the Principal Act." Principal Act.

3 The definition of "Works" in Section Four of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the word "and" in the tenth line of the said definition, and substituting the word "or" therefor.

4 The area of land shewn in the plan in the schedule to this Act, and in such plan surrounded by red boundary lines, shall, from and after the commencement of this Act, be and form the Light District for the purposes of the Principal Act, in substitution for the area of land shown in the plan referred to in Section Five of the Principal Act.

5 Section Twenty-nine of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting all the words of the said section after the word "If" in the first line thereof down to and including the word "District" in the third line thereof.

6 It shall be lawful for the Council, from time to time, to enter into an agreement with the Minister, or other authority for the time being controlling the affairs of the Hydro-Electric Department of the State, for the purchase by the Council from such Minister, or other authority as aforesaid, for the purposes of the Principal Act, of electrical energy in bulk upon such terms and conditions in all respects as shall be mutually agreed upon between the parties to such agreement.

7--(1) It shall be lawful for the Council, on behalf of the Corporation, without having previously passed any special resolution for the purpose, to borrow under the provisions of "The State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921," in addition to any moneys previously borrowed under the authority of the Principal Act, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Seven thousand five hundred Pounds, for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses incidental to the preparation and passing of this Act and the carrying out of the provisions of the Principal Act and this Act.

(2) All moneys borrowed under the authority of this section shall, for the purposes of Part VII. of the Principal Act, be deemed to have been borrowed under the Principal Act.

8 The poll of the electors within the Light District, taken on the twenty-third day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, shall be a sufficient compliance with any law requiring a poll of such electors to be taken before the Council shall be permitted to proceed to borrow any moneys authorised to be borrowed under this Act.

Sinking fund.

9 The amount payable by the Council as an annual contribution towards a sinking fund in respect of any moneys borrowed under this Act shall be an amount equal to Two Pounds per centum of the moneys so borrowed.

10 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to borrow, raise, and receive a total sum not exceeding Seven thousand five hundred Pounds for the purposes of the Principal Act and this Act.
