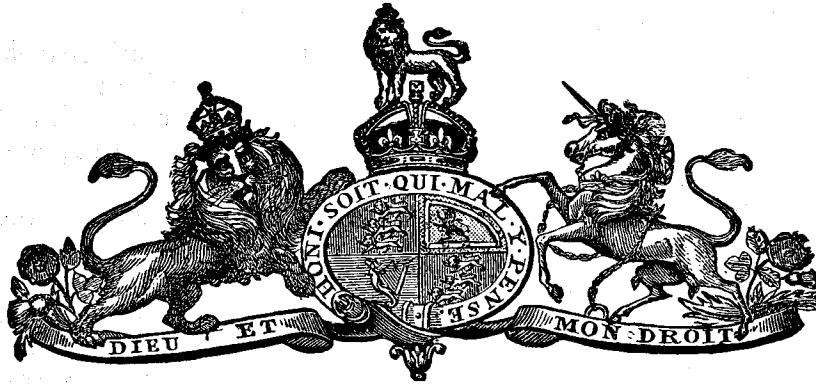

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AN ACT to provide for the Execution of <sup>A.D.</sup> 1924.  
 certain State Railway Works, and for other  
 purposes. [18 March, 1924.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Railway Works Execution Short title. Act, 1924.”

**2** In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—  
 “Minister” means the Minister for Railways for the time being. Interpretation.

*State Railway Works Execution.*

A.D. 1924.

Minister to cause rolling-stock, &c., to be provided and works to be constructed.

**3** It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be—

- I. Purchased, provided, and acquired, any land, rolling-stock and things mentioned in the schedules to this Act :
- II. Undertaken, constructed, improved, executed, completed, and carried out, the various undertakings, works, objects, and purposes mentioned in the schedules to this Act—

at a cost therefor not exceeding in each case the total amount for the same set forth in the said schedules.

Cost how to be defrayed.

**4** The cost of purchasing, providing, and acquiring such land, rolling-stock, and things, and of undertaking, constructing, improving, executing, completing, and carrying out such undertakings, works, objects, and purposes, shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Act partly retrospective.

**5** The provisions of this Act, so far as the same apply to the land, rolling-stock, undertakings, and purposes mentioned in Schedules One and Two, shall have a retrospective operation.
