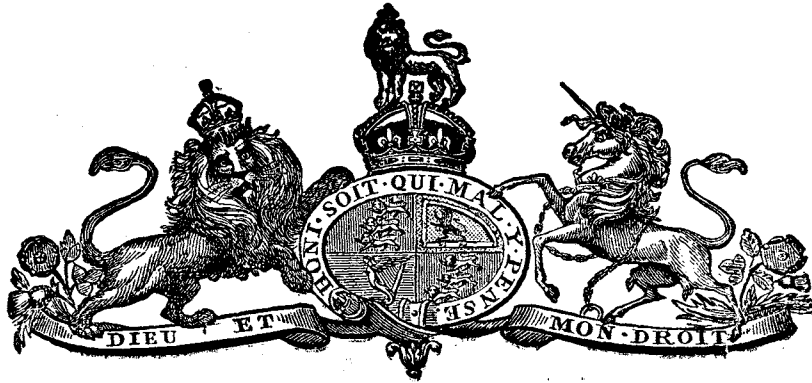

AN ACT to extend the Application of a certain Regulation made under the Forestry Act, 1920, and to validate the Collection and Payment of certain Timber Royalties thereunder. [25 July, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Timber Royalties Validation Act, 1929.” Short title.

2 The regulation made under the Forestry Act, 1920, on the eighteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and published in the Gazette of the twenty-ninth day of the same month, shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and to have had Extension of a certain regulation under 11 Geo.V. full force and effect, to the exclusion of any other regulation on the same matter purporting to be then in force, on and from the lastmentioned date up to and including the twenty-eighth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.

3 All royalties charged, collected, and paid in pursuance of the regulation extended aforesaid in respect of the periods of such extension, are hereby declared to have been lawfully charged, collected, and paid.
