An Act to revise the Statute Law and for other purposes.

[29th November, 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Statute Law* Short title.
Revision Act 1955.

2. The Acts mentioned in the Schedule to this Act to the extent to which they are in and by the said Schedule expressed to be amended are hereby amended accordingly. Amendments to be made in Acts. Schedule.

3. The Government Printer of Victoria may, after receiving a certificate of the Attorney-General in that behalf, issue copies of any of the Acts amended by this Act with the amendments provided for by this Act. Issuing by Government Printer of Acts as amended.
