An Act to revise the Statute Law.

) E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):---

1. This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Revision Act short uite. 1962.

2. The Acts mentioned in the Schedules to this Act to the Amendments extent to which the same are in and by the said Schedules expressed in Acts. to be amended are hereby amended accordingly and the said schedules. Acts shall be read and construed accordingly.
