An Act relating to the Parliamentary
Joint Statute Law Revision Committee.

[28th December, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Statute Law Revision Committee Act 1916.* Short title.

2. Every joint statute law revision committee of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly shall hold office as such joint committee and exercise all the powers conferred upon it by any Act or otherwise, for the session during which it is appointed, and thence until—

- (a) the day before the commencement of a new session of Parliament ; or
- (b) the expiry of the Assembly by the effluxion of time ; or
- (c) the dissolution of either or both Houses of Parliament,

whichever of such events first happens.
