An Act to amend Section Four of the *Statute Law Revision Committee Act 1948.*

[20th September, 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Statute Law Revision Committee (Amendment) Act 1955* and shall be read and construed as one with *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1928* and any Act amending the same all of which Acts and this Act may be cited together as *The Constitution Act Amendment Acts.*

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of August One thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.
